

How we offer the **30 hours Funded** Childcare at Kevin Pearce Children's Centre

We currently offer the 30 hours funded childcare over three days, totalling 10 hours a day. The session times for this are 7.45am to 5.45pm. With this offer there is a daily cost of £5 a session for consumables during funded periods.

In non funded periods you have the option to attend. If you do attend the price is £41 for a full day or £25 for a morning or afternoon session.

How we offer the **FREE Two Year old Early** **Education Funding and the Universal 15 hours** **Early Education Funding for 3 and 4 year olds** at Kevin Pearce Children's Centre

Option 1

We offer 5 morning sessions 8.15-11.15am there are no charges with this option.

Option 2

We offer 5 afternoon sessions 12.15--3.15pm there are no charges with this option.

Option 3

We offer 2 days 9.00-3.00pm and a either a morning 8.15-11.15am or an afternoon 12.15-3.15pm there are no charges with this option.

Option 4

We offer two days 8.30-4.00

Any additional hours accessed not in the options above will be charged at £39 for a full day or £23 for a morning or afternoon session.

Shift Patterns.

As a setting we cater for shift patterns to support our families individual needs. Due to the impact of this on ratio's we offer 1 place in the Mini Movers Unit and 2 in the Early Years Unit. There is the expectation that a set minimum charge is paid each week. For further details, as each request is different please approach the Deputy Children's Centre Manager.

Is your child 3 or 4 years old?

You may be entitled to 30 hours Funded Early Education Funding.



You can usually get 30 hours free childcare if you (and your partner, if you have one) are:

- in work - or getting parental leave, sick leave or annual leave
- each earning at least the National Minimum Wage or Living Wage for 16 hours a week - this is £125.28 if you're over 25
- This earnings limit does not apply if you're self-employed and started your business less than 12 months ago.

You're not eligible if:

- your child does not usually live with you
 - the child is your foster child
- either you or your partner has a taxable income over £100,000
- you're from outside the EEA and your UK residence card says you cannot access public funds

You can get 30 hours free childcare at the same time as claiming Universal Credit, tax credits or childcare vouchers.

Apply for 30 hours funded childcare at childcarechoices.gov.uk

You'll need your details (and your partner's, if you have one), including your:

-National Insurance number

-Unique Taxpayer Reference (UTR), if you're self-employed
It usually takes 20 minutes to apply. You may find out if you're eligible straight away, but it can take up to 7 days

Why should I consider using a FREE Early Education Funding place?

Research has shown that good quality early education can:
Improve children's development, for example their communication and social skills,
Help them learn to mix with other children and make friends,
Help them begin to prepare for school,
Give them access to exciting places to play and new activities including educational, messy, sensory and physical that are all tailored to their individual interests and needs.

2 year EEF

There is a criteria for this funding, if you think your child may be entitled to this funding please contact the centre where we will support you in completing a check to confirm eligibility.

3 and 4 year EEF

All children in England get 570 free hours per year. You can get it from the term after your child's 3rd
