Energy and Water

- 1.1a We will work to reduce the amount of waste produced by wherever possible reducing consumption, repairing, re-using and recycling
- 1.1b We will attempt to keep use of paper and printing to a minimum, e.g. only print when necessary and use both sides of paper

Transport

1.1a We will monitor and work to reduce our contribution to environmental emissions from travel undertaken for business purposes by encouraging staff to use car sharing, public transport or walk / cycle where appropriate
